

## Astrology and diagnosis in west and east: what is reality? Psychosis or kundalini?

We tend to understand the world we see from our scientific point of view, based on a certain paradigm. We grow up in this world, learn to see the things in the dominant way, and only when young we are allowed to be in a similar state as the natural tribes. But we as adults call it phantasy. But what is normal? Members of natural tribes learned from early age on that the invisible world is as real as the normal world, and they can travel in it, communicate with the spirits, heal people with herbs of which they say that the herbs themselves tell them how to use them etc. Is this 'just phantasy'?

Maybe this unseen world is very much alive and around us. But we have not learned how to look at the signals. It does not fit in our way of thinking and explaining, so for us it simply does not exist. We call it superstition.

This brings me to astrology. I have been an active member of the Dutch Society for Scientific Study of Parapsychology for 25 years, and because of my knowledge of parapsychological phenomena, I had quite a number of clients who have had experiences they could not explain, could not talk about, but were trying to integrate in their lives. But when I started to see these clients, there was no literature whatsoever in astrology about these phenomena. We understand the planets on their material and psychological level. After studying and collecting charts of many people who had extraordinary experiences, I am convinced that there is a third level on which planets operate, especially the outer planets, and as we have no special word for it, I started to call it the shamanistic level.

In this lecture I will show an in-depth example of one of my clients (with her permission) who had extraordinary experiences but was diagnosed psychotic. Looking at it in a different way, it could well have been a real kundalini experience.
