

The End of the Bronze Age as a Message for Our Time

There are so many different things we hear and read on television and newspapers; items that seem unrelated. We hear about ebola in Africa, sanctions against Russia and Iran, we heard about decapitations by ISIS-terrorists of the Islamic State, droughts in some areas of the world and heavy rain in other areas and very cold winters in parts of the US. The reason was that in the decades around this date the great civilization of the Bronze Age fell apart in an eerie speed, especially in the two decades following 1177 BC.
